The PCE grain team has recently added four semis and grain trailers to our business in the desire to grow our service to farmers. You may now sell grain FOB the farm and we will arrange our trucks to pick up your grain and deliver to the best market. As our trucks pick up your grain, they will leave you a bill of lading as receipt of grain. When your grain settlement is mailed back to you, you will be able to match off your bill of lading with the destination unload ticket to ensure payment for each load. We do have a strict set of safety rules our drivers must follow for their protection, your protection and that of the company.

- NO DRIVER MAY ENTER A BIN AT ANY TIME.

- DRIVERS MUST OBSERVE THE SAME PPE AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS AS THEY DO WHEN ON COMPANY PROPERTY.
- DRIVER MAY NOT MOVE EQUIPMENT OR AUGERS.
- FARMERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS OF LOADING EQUIPMENT AND ACCESS TO BIN SITES.
- IF AN UNSAFE LOADING ENVIRONMENT IS OBSERVED, DRIVERS WILL NOT BE ABLE TO LOAD. IE. UNGUARDED AUGERS, UNGUARDED PTO SHAFTS, ICE ACCUMULATION AROUND BINS, ETC.

This technology will help reduce overlap, improve application in tough terrain, & give us improved efficiency in rough ground.
